**Band:** Report time 7:45 a.m.; rehearsal runs 8:00 - 10:00 a.m. at Conrad Weiser HS **Chorus:** Report time 10:15 a.m.; rehearsal runs 10:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. at Conrad Weiser HS **Orchestra:** Report time 12:45 p.m.; rehearsal runs 1:00 - 3:00 p.m. at Conrad Weiser HS

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: Students must attend all rehearsals for their performing group(s) <u>IN THEIR ENTIRETY</u>. Students who cannot/do not attend the rehearsals in their entirety <u>INCLUDING BEING LATE FOR</u> <u>REHEARSAL(S)</u> (for any reason, including illness) will not be permitted to participate in the concert and will be replaced by an alternate. This rule applies to both the weekday and Saturday rehearsals and is strictly enforced.

#### DRESS FOR THE CONCERT:

Either <u>performance-appropriate length dress</u> or skirt and blouse combination, dress shoes OR suit or sport coat with dress pants, dress shirt, tie, dress shoes. (<u>NO mini-skirts/dresses</u>. NO flip-flop type footwear. NO stiletto style heels.) Students who are not dressed appropriately will not be permitted to perform.

**TICKETS:** All seats are one price: \$6.00 each. Please see your director or the MEBC website for information regarding ticket orders. The presale ticket limit for this concert is three (3) per student. Remaining tickets (if any) will be available to purchase after all students have received their 3 tickets.

# <u>RECORDINGS</u>: The concert will be professionally recorded and a recording will be made available to the students after the performance.

**LUNCH:** Lunch may be purchased at Host High School during each of the weekday rehearsals. Students may also choose to pack their lunch. Directors will receive an email from the host directors prior to the rehearsal week with lunch information for distribution to students.

**MUSIC RETURN:** Please return all music for each performing group the night of the concert immediately following the group's performance. Students in multiple groups must make arrangements to have music turned in from group(s) earlier in the concert order. It is the responsibility of each home director to see that all music is returned.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Prior to your group's rehearsal day, all participants must complete and submit to their home director(s) a copy of the "Emergency Form" in order to participate. Copies of this form should be secured from your home director. Your director MUST bring your form to the rehearsal day and present it to the Vice-President in charge of the rehearsal. (You will need a copy for each group you are in. Students in multiple groups should photocopy the completed form prepared for their first rehearsing group and give copies to their home director for the second and/or third rehearsing group.)
